Welcome to MATH 115L 721_24U Calculus for Management Application. This class will be taught entirely on-line. The course is delivered through Brightspace Platform our online collaborative learning environment. Students will use their Marist Account and password to access the contents of the course 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Marist's summer 8-week online course formats are equivalent to traditional semester- length Marist courses. Students spend at least five hours per week on the internet and roughly eight to twelve hours per week on homework (reading and completing the assignments).

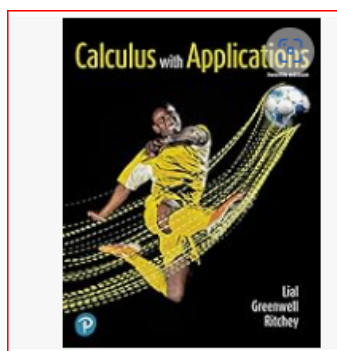
